We are pleased to present the latest developments in the Digital Inclusion VET project, an initiative co-funded by Erasmus+ dedicated to equipping unemployed people over the age of 45 with the digital skills essential for the Industry 4.0 era. Our mission is to facilitate their reintegration into the labour market through innovative digital training and professional development.

The project has made significant progress, marked by important transnational meetings across Europe, which have fostered collaboration and shaped the future of digital education and vocational training.

Key Meetings and Progress:

The Digital Inclusion VET project held a significant Transnational Project Meeting (TPM) in **Thessaloniki**, Greece, on October 21 and 22, 2024. This meeting was crucial for reviewing the progress and ensuring the sustainability of Work Package 2. Additionally, partners initiated the planning phase for Work Package 3, outlining the next steps for the project's development.

Another key Transnational Project Meeting for the Digital Inclusion VET project took place in **Zaragoza**, Spain, on January 15, 2025. This comprehensive meeting covered three main areas: the successful conclusion of Work Package 2, the ongoing development of Work Package 3, and strategic planning for the upcoming Work Package 4, setting the stage for future activities and deliverables.



Trapani Meeting (Italy)



The fourth transnational meeting of the Digital Inclusion VET project took place recently in Trapani, Italy, on 14 May 2025. Held in the picturesque Chiostro di San Domenico, in collaboration with the D50 social and health district, this meeting marked an important milestone. The partners gathered to review the activities carried out and define the next steps to determine the project's outcomes. The consortium also had the opportunity to present its collaborative efforts and the results achieved to Giuseppe Virzì, local councillor for Social Services, Family Services and Labour Policies.

Project Outcomes to Date

The Digital Inclusion VET project is developing innovative training materials to achieve its objectives. These include:

- A free e-manual for VET teachers on digitalisation and virtualisation.
- A free online platform to train people over 45 in digital skills and Industry 4.0.
- A specific app (currently under development) to provide information on new job offers and refresher courses available across the EU and in participating countries.

We are convinced that these resources will contribute significantly to reducing the digital divide and improving the employability of people over 45 across Europe.
