




The next steps of the project

The GREEN4ADU project is rolling out a series of learning workshops focused on psycho-physical wellbeing and awareness-raising. Taking place in Apeldoorn, Palermo, Thessaloniki, Salamanca, and Bremen, each workshop combines theoretical content with outdoor activities, encouraging reflection and action on climate and environmental challenges. With 4 sessions involving at least 15 participants (adult learners, educators, and activists,) the workshops promote "learning by doing," empowering participants to develop transversal skills while co-leading activities. The next step will be the development of the GREEN4ADU Toolkit, gathering methodologies, practices, and results to inspire replication across Europe.
