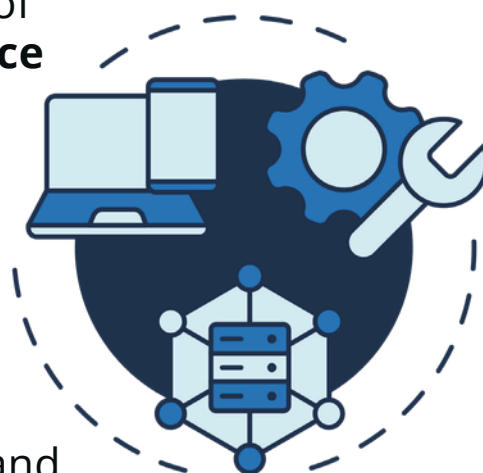


Progress and next priorities

2nd Transnational
Project Meeting

On **1 and 2 October 2025**, partners of the Erasmus+ project **WIN – Workplace Inclusion: Neurodiversity** met in Foligno (Italy) for the project's **2nd Transnational Project Meeting**, hosted by **EGInA** at the Centro Studi Città di Foligno.

Over two working days, the international consortium reviewed progress and next priorities across the project work packages. Partners discussed **project achievements and pending outputs**, with a focus on **quality review and improvement actions (WP1)**, the finalisation and dissemination opportunities of the **Best Practices output (WP2)**, and updates on the **WIN website and app development (WP4)**.



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The meeting also advanced **WP3 resources**, including the training programme for adult educators, the **induction plan for employers**, and the **mentoring programme** supporting neurodivergence in the work environment.

A key milestone was the joint planning of the upcoming **three-day training course in Slovenia**: partners discussed the **programme, learning activities and organisational arrangements** for the event scheduled for **25–27 November 2025 in Ljubljana**.

The consortium concluded by confirming the next steps, including final revisions of outputs, continued digital development, strengthened dissemination actions, and preparation for piloting and implementation activities in the coming months.
